## CLEVER FAQ

- 1. **What is Clever?** Clever is a single-sign on platform, so any programs the district has that works with Clever has been placed in it.
- 2. **How do I get my students a Clever account?** Students already have clever accounts.
- 3. **Can students access Clever at home?** Yes. To access Clever, go to the LPSB.org website and click on Digital Help. Clever is 8<sup>th</sup> on the chart.
- 4. What is the student login?

Username-1st initial, last name (may have to add a number) Ex. Lkennedy2

**Passwor**d-First 3 letters of first name (Cap. 1st letter), last 4 digits of SS, Exclamation point Ex. Lyn1234!

5. What is the teacher login?

Username-LPSB email address

**Password**-First 3 letters of first name, last 4 digits of your SS#, exclamation point (Lyn1234!)\*\*Capitalize first letter of password (Change to your preference after your initial login)

\*\*Note, if the teacher does not have classes in powerschool or students assigned to them in powerschool, they cannot access Clever.

- **6. What is in Clever?** These programs include PLATO/Edmentum, Springboard, CommonLit, i-Ready, Rosetta Stone, Sapling Learning, IXL, Seesaw (Prek-2) and Reflex SSO. Not all programs are available to all students. More are being added when they become available.
- **7. What does "single-sign on" mean?** When students log in to Clever, they do not have to log in to the other programs- Clever automatically logs them in to those programs.
- **8.** Can teachers add apps into Clever? Teachers can also go in and create dashboards of popular websites/apps, *however it will not be single-sign on*. The student will still have to log in to that program.
- 9. If a teacher adds something from the Clever Library, will it be single sign-on? No.
- 10. **Will any program work inside Clever?** Unfortunately, some programs will not work with Clever.
